

2023-2024 Spring Immunization Campaign Guide

Comprehensive Student Health Services

Overview

Florida Statute 1003.22, Rule 64D-3.046 of the Florida Administrative Code, and school board policy 5320 mandates that **ALL** children entering, attending, or transferring into school in grades kindergarten (KG) through 12 must have a Florida Certificate of Immunization (DH Form 680) indicating the student has the immunization requirements for the required grade level.

Each October, Florida Statute 1003.22 requires the District to submit an annual immunization report of compliance to the Florida Department of Education and the Florida Department of Health.

- 1. Students entering **Kindergarten Fall 2023** must obtain the 2nd MMR (<u>Mumps</u>, <u>Measles</u>, and <u>Rubella</u>) and the 2nd <u>Varicella</u> vaccine.
- 2. Students entering the **7th** grade **Fall 2023** must obtain the **Tdap** booster (**Tetanus Diphtheria Pertussis**) vaccine.
- 3. Students in <u>ALL grades</u> with an **expired** immunization status must present a new Florida Certificate of Immunization-680 form.

INITIAL HEALTH ENTRY REGISTRATION
