



# 2024 Spring Immunization Campaign Guide

Comprehensive Student Health Services

## Overview

Florida Statute 1003.22, Rule 64D-3.046 of the Florida Administrative Code, and school board policy 5320 collectively require that every child entering, attending, or transferring into school in grades kindergarten (KG) through 12 must have a Florida Certificate of Immunization (DH Form 680) indicating the student has met the immunization requirements for the required grade level.

Each October, Florida Statute 1003.22 requires the District to submit an annual immunization report of compliance to the Florida Department of Education.

1. Students entering **Kindergarten Fall 2024** must obtain the 2nd MMR ([Mumps](#), [Measles](#), and [Rubella](#)) and the 2<sup>nd</sup> [Varicella](#) vaccine.
2. Students entering the **7th grade Fall 2024** must obtain the [Tdap](#) booster ([Tetanus Diphtheria Pertussis](#)) vaccine.
3. Students in **ALL grades** with an **expired** immunization status must present a **new** Florida Certificate of Immunization-680 form.

# INITIAL HEALTH ENTRY REGISTRATION

- Students that do not have the medical documentation at the time of registration that meet the criteria listed below have 30-days to bring in the required health records.
  - Refer to School Board Policy 5330 for additional information.

## Exceptions: (30-day Exemptions)

- Displaced Students (Project UP-START)
- Unified Children’s Court System (Delinquency/Dependent)
- Children of Military Families



## Initial School Entry Health Exam (DH-3040)

Must be performed within twelve (12) months by a medical provider.

**MUST** include a **tuberculosis clinical screening only**.

- Based on the outcome of the TB questionnaire screening, the medical provider will determine if the student needs the TB test (injection).

A positive (+) screening test will require a follow-up skin test.

The student may enroll **ONLY** with a medical provider's statement that the student is free of communicable tuberculosis and can attend school.

- Students transferring from within the state of Florida or a student that was previously enrolled in M-DCPS are **NOT** required to be re-examined.

## Florida Certification of Immunization (DH-680)

Students enrolling in school for the first time or transferring into:

M-DCPS from out-of-state **MUST** present **one** of the following:

### 1. Part A- CODE-1

- ALL** immunization requirements are met. No additional immunizations are needed at this time.

### 2. Part B-CODE 2

- Temporary Medical Exemption, the student must have a **valid** immunization code.

### 3. Part C-CODE 3

- Permanent Medical Exemption- child cannot receive one or more vaccines.
- The medical provider must indicate on the Florida Certificate of Immunization which vaccine the student is medical exempt from receiving.

### 4. CODE 4

- Religious Certificate of Immunization (DH-681)
- Issued **ONLY** by DOH for a child who is not immunized because of his/her family's religious beliefs.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The Florida Certificate of Immunization **MUST** match the immunization code inputted in DSIS.

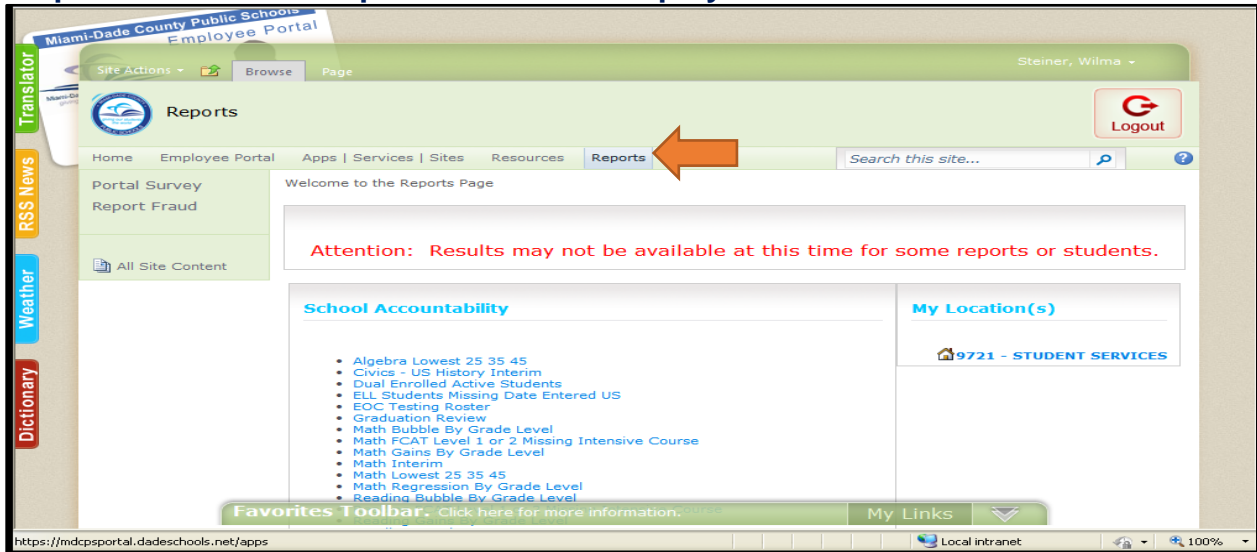

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRINCIPALS

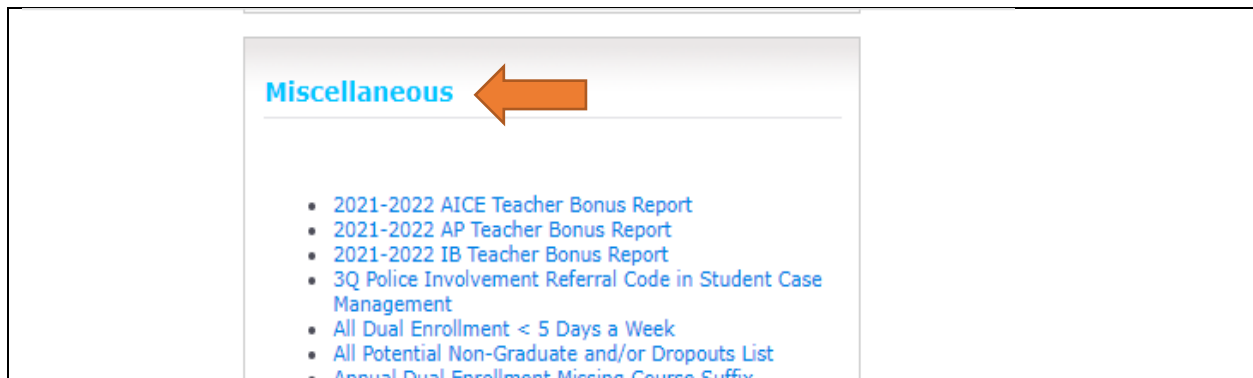
- Please **share** the weekly briefing and the 2024 Spring Immunization Campaign Guide with your school registrar.
- Ensure your registrar has access to the school's immunization compliance report.
- The principal and the registrar **must** review the school's immunization compliance report weekly. The immunization compliance report provides real time daily updates.

### Step 1: Click on the Reports Tab in the Employee Portal



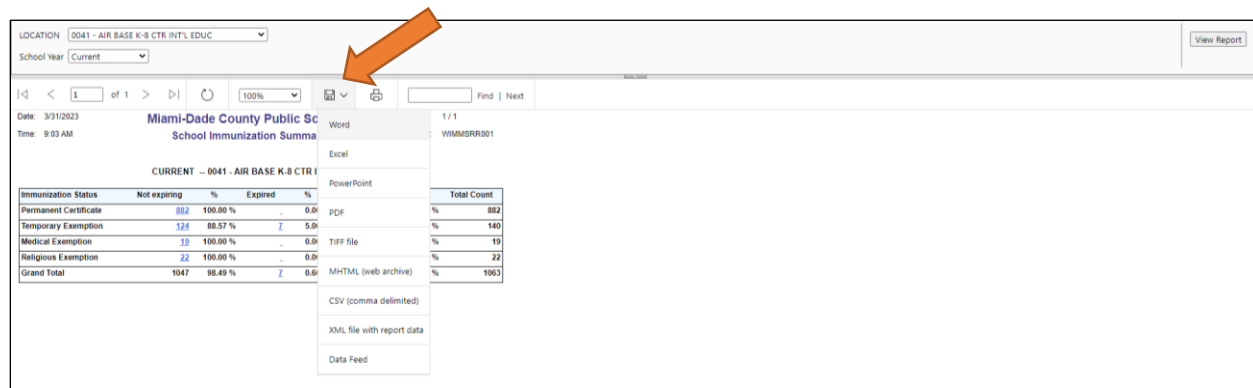
### Step 2: Scroll to the Miscellaneous Header

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTRAR

- Print the following from your school’s immunization compliance report:
  - Students who have an **expired** immunization status
  - Students who have an immunization status that will expire **in 30 days**
  - Students who are futured for **Kindergarten (KG) Fall of 2024**
  - Students who are futured for **7<sup>th</sup> grade Fall 2024**

- Students **futured** for grades KG and 7<sup>th</sup> can be located under the **“Temporary Exemption-Not expiring tab”**

- Contact the parent/guardian of the students listed on each immunization compliance report and informed them of their child(ren)’s immunization status.
- Inform the parent/guardian that a letter will be sent home with their child regarding their immunization status.
- Print the letter included in the weekly briefing.
- Provide the letter to the following students:
  - Students who have an **expired** immunization status
  - Students who have an immunization status that will expire **in 30 days**
  - Students who are futured for **Kindergarten (KG) Fall of 2024**
  - Students who are futured for **7<sup>th</sup> grade Fall 2024**

- If the registrar or principal does not know how to access the immunization compliance report, please contact the Office of District Operations | Comprehensive Student Health Services at (305) 995-4111.
- The District will be partnering with our school-based partners to offer **FREE** school-age vaccines at select elementary, middle, and K-8 schools.
- Schools will be selected based on the total number of students that **have not** received the mandatory KG and 7<sup>th</sup> grade-level vaccine Fall 2024.
- Select principals will receive an email with the date your school will be participating in the Spring Immunization Campaign.
- The email will include additional instructions and the school-based providers consent form.
- Students **must** have a signed consent for to receive the vaccine at the school site.
- The parent/guardian does not have to be present for the student to receive the vaccine at the school site.
- This is a great opportunity to target students on your school's immunization compliance report that have an **EXPIRED, EXPIRING in 30 DAYS, or FUTURED for grades KG and 7<sup>th</sup> Fall 2024.**
- Parents/guardians can contact their child's medical provider if they have any questions regarding what vaccines their child needs for school.

According to Florida's school immunization law (**1003.25-Florida Statutes**), all students attending school must have proper immunization documentation.

It is imperative that you take your child to their medical provider or schedule an appointment with the Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County's immunization program by calling 786-845-0550. If your child has already received the required school-age vaccine, it is essential that you take the updated **Florida Certificate of Immunization DH-680** form to your child's school.
